

Prairie Island Tribal Court Method of Service Form

The Prairie Island Indian Community Tribal Court allows parties to decide whether to accept service of documents by U.S. Mail, electronic mail, or e-mail service with a courtesy paper copy by U.S. Mail. It is the responsibility of a sending party to ensure that the document transmits electronically. The Court encourages parties to use read receipts to confirm delivery.

The Tribal Court may also provide parties with courtesy text reminders of deadlines. The Tribal Court will only use the information provided on this form to contact you concerning litigation and Tribal Court business.

If you consent to email service and later change your email address, or if you consent to text messaging and later change your mobile number, then you must complete this form again with the new contact information. The Court will presume that the information on the most recent form is correct. If you do not return this form, you will not receive electronic service or texts from the Court or other parties.
